With an associates degree in Human Services from Bristol Community College and a bachelor's degree in Psychology from Bridgewater State University, Ms. Marshall has the skills to help students succeed! Ms. Marshall Q & A WITH KRISTEN MARSHALL

Tell me about your background. What led you to this position with SCP?

"When I was a senior attending a trade school, there was little to no counseling or resources available for students looking to plan for a post-secondary career. During my senior year, BCC was having an open enrollment day, and I just walked up to the booth and signed up. It was one of the best decisions I have ever made and I am so happy that I decided to further my education. I have a great deal of respect for the SCP as this is a service I truly wish I had for myself in high school! As a first generation college student I am very passionate about advocating for career services so others can get the help they may not even realize they need!"

What have you learned from past experiences that will help you succeed in this position?

"Prior to accepting this position I was working as an Employment Specialist. In that role I arranged student internships and and provided coaching while documenting progress. I enjoyed interacting with students, but I also like the camaraderie as everyone was so involved with the work that was being done. I also have experience providing employment seeking services including resume help, mock interviews, benefit calculations, and on the job coaching, which I anticipate will relay nicely to SCP. My collective experience with helping individuals overcome barriers is very beneficial to the position I am in now!"

What do you enjoy most about working with students?

"I like that working with students is super unique and as Career Specialists we get to instill excellence! I aspire to be the motivating force that drives student success and helps them carry the motivation that will follow them forever. If students are taught that work is a privilege, not a chore, each and every day can be better and more exciting."

What are you most excited about to work on with AHS and the Attleboro Community?

"In this virtual world we are all facing new challenges and overcoming obstacles to the best of our abilities. Let's face it, it's a road we've never been down before. For the upcoming school year (although it terrifies me), I am looking forward to seeing how we are able to continue converting our world from in-person to virtual. To kick off the year I've been figuring out the logistics of virtual job fairs and gaining access to virtual job shadow programs. To see employers in our community pull together to help the students has been a genuinely humbling experience. It would be so simple for businesses to wash their hands of work based learning during a pandemic, however the Attleboro community will not let our students suffer or fall through the cracks. I am excited to get to know our community partners and create more meaningful relationships!"

In your opinion, how do you think students can best prepare for the workforce?

"There is no one pathway to success. Each student is different and will need varying types of support. School to Career is a great program because there is no "cookie-cutter template" that we use to encourage students. Everyone is met where they are and we work alongside students to get them to where they want to be. Whether their goal is to find a first job, create a resume, or explore a bunch of different careers. I am here to assist."
