2019 Summer of Work and Learning Program

This summer we were able to place 20 students at work sites in the Attleboro area, including Sturdy Memorial Hospital and Attleboro High School's Culinary Program, Farm 2 Table Initiative, and Utilities Crew.

Students on the Utilities Crew worked on various projects throughout the building including painting projects in classrooms and the welding shop. Our culinary students learned the ins and outs of a commercial kitchen by preparing food for students and staff. In addition to this, students prepared large batch meals for local soup kitchen, Lenore's Pantry. Not only did these students hone their culinary skills, they obtained their ServSafe Food Handler certification.

A special thanks to the Attleboro Land Trust, who were hugely instrumental in providing various work projects for our Farm 2 Table crew. At the Deborah and Roger Richardson Nature Preserve, our students assisted in various projects including the installment of an irrigation system, renovation of a tool shed, and the planting of a traditional colonial garden.

In addition to meaningful work experience, students participated in a classroom component, which provides a curriculum to help students identify skills and interests directly related to career development. The Signal Success curriculum also covers financial literacy, resume building, interviewing skills, and professional communication.
