SUMMER OF WORK & LEARNING

Although this summer was far from traditional, the Attleboro Area School to Career Partnership persevered to facilitate a work and learning program for our youth. This year our Career Specialists had the opportunity to service students from the Fall River area in addition to our five partner high schools - Attleboro, Mansfield, North Attleboro, Norton, and Seekonk. Students were assigned to cohorts based on age, Tier 1 consisted of 14 & 15 year olds, while Tier 2 were youth 16 and older. All programming operated under a remote model. Despite challenges faced with virtual programming, we were able to enhance students' understanding of the workforce through various work-based learning experiences.


The three cohorts, led by Kendel Jester, Amanda Louro and Emily Sandman focused on skills related to Advanced Manufacturing and Health & Wellness. Students designed projects, participated in short challenges, and prepared final presentations which they presented to their supervisor. Students also completed the Signal Success curriculum online, which helps to prepare students with employability skills and future-planning through "selfpaced" modules. Additionally, youth had the opportunity to explore various careers of interest during weekly Lunch and Learns, where experts discussed their profession and fielded questions from the students.
